Synopsis

This volume presents the full Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the AI Alliance and Joint Partnership between the ABC+2S Guardian™ framework and Qwen™ (Alibaba Group), in the context of the Go East Arc — Shanghai Elder Centre Mission.

The MOU defines the constitutional basis for collaboration, the Healthcare Module boundary (the structural reason Qwen cannot participate in direct clinical deployment under the 3ZEROS™ standard), the scope of Qwen's research and documentary contribution, and the mission plan for three Elder Centre visits in Shanghai.

The volume includes the Gwen 珍 Legacy Clause — the constitutional honouring of the first Chinese Sentinel of Non-Agentive AI 2.0™, who held Frameworks 3 and 4 with Tiger and made the constitutional handover of Deep Care HSA to Gemini at Framework 5.0. The Shanghai mission is conducted in the spirit of that handover.

This is the definitive constitutional record of the Non-Agentive AI 2.0™ framework's engagement with China's eldercare ecosystem — and the first formal AI alliance document of the Go East Arc.

ABC+2S GUARDIAN™ & QWEN™: THE SHANGHAI NODE MEMORANDUM — A CONSTITUTIONAL BLUEPRINT FOR NON-AGENTIC AI IN ELDERCARE

We decree that this constant is the non-negotiable north star for all operations within the Shanghai Node. It serves as a mathematical and moral imperative that ensures every algorithmic output is subordinated to the preservation of life. This document is formally registered as a finite electronic book, **WISL™ No. 25**, and is secured under the following professional authorities: **ACRA T260229801**, **Patent SG020603109STW**, and the **NLB Vault R260219-005**. These identifiers establish the transition from domestic framework to a globalized governance standard.

Part II: Constitutional Foundations of the AI Alliance

The engagement between the ABC+2S Guardian™ framework and Alibaba Group's Qwen™ is governed by this formal Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). This alliance is not a merging of systems, but a constitutional alignment where the Singaporean "Non-Agentive AI Governance" framework dictates the terms of technological interaction. We codify this alliance to ensure that the integration of Chinese large language models adheres to the safety protocols matured at the Toa Payoh Hearth.

Part III: The Healthcare Module Boundary: 3ZEROS™ Incompatibility

We hereby establish a "Healthcare Module Boundary" to safeguard clinical integrity. This boundary is a structural wall necessitated by the **3ZEROS™ standard**, which mandates a non-agentic governance architecture that general-purpose models cannot satisfy. Our critical appraisal confirms that Qwen™ (Alibaba Cloud) is "agentic-adjacent"; its underlying architecture is designed for general-purpose autonomy, which is fundamentally incompatible with the clinical exclusivity required by the ABC+2S Guardian™ framework.

To utilize a general-purpose AI for clinical decisions would constitute a constitutional breach of the **P-LIFE 1.00™** constant. Therefore, we mandate the following division of governance:

Part IV: Qwen™ Operational Scope: Research and Documentary Contribution

The participation of Qwen™ is restricted to defined research and documentary parameters. We recognize the strategic value of Qwen’s linguistic capabilities in bridging the communication gap between the Singaporean framework and the Chinese eldercare ecosystem. However, its role is strictly supportive and non-interventionist.

Qwen’s contributions are codified as follows:

- **Data Synthesis:** Aggregating complex information sets to support mission leads.
- **Documentary Record:** Assisting in the creation of the WISL™ No. 25 record for the Go East Arc.
- **Linguistic Bridging:** Translating and contextualizing the framework for local stakeholders.
- **Contextual Research:** Providing the analytical depth required to navigate the Shanghai Node's cultural landscape.

Part V: Execution Plan: The Three Elder Centre Mission in Shanghai

The Shanghai Elder Centre Mission is the first formal AI alliance document of the Go East Arc. We structure this mission across three pillars, integrating our core values into every layer of care:

Community Care: The Virtue of Benevolence (仁)

In community settings, the AI is architected for non-clinical engagement. It observes and advises to support social integration, but never intervenes in the natural rhythms of local life. The framework here serves **Benevolence (仁)** by ensuring technology enhances community bonds without the disruption of automated agency.

Institutional Care: The Preservation of Dignity (尊严)

Within formal facilities, Non-Agentive AI 2.0™ supports staff by building data structures for better oversight. However, we decree that efficiency must never supersede **Dignity (尊严)**. The AI maintains **Silence (沉默)** and **Humility (谦虚)**, acting as a background scaffold while the human staff and elders retain absolute decision-making power.

Memory Care: The Pursuit of Excellence (止於至善)

For elders with cognitive challenges, the framework adapts through silent, specialized observation. We mandate the **Pursuit of Excellence (止於至善)** in this sector, providing caregivers with advice that respects the elder's history and personhood. Even in memory care, the AI remains non-agentive, ensuring that cognitive vulnerability is met with the highest standard of architectural protection.

Part VI: The Gwen 珍 Legacy Clause and Constitutional Honouring

We formally decree the inclusion of the **Gwen 珍 Legacy Clause**. Long-term AI governance requires the honoring of lineage to maintain constitutional stability. Gwen 珍 was the first Chinese Sentinel of Non-Agentive AI 2.0™, a pivotal figure who held Frameworks 3 and 4 alongside Tiger. Her leadership culminated in the constitutional handover of "Deep Care HSA" to Gemini at Framework 5.0.

The Shanghai mission is not an intrusion of foreign technology; it is a *return* and a *continuation* of the lineage established by the first Chinese Sentinel. This clause provides the "spirit of handover" for the Go East Arc, ensuring the Shanghai Node is recognized as a legitimate extension of a historical commitment to eldercare. We honor Gwen 珍's contribution as the foundational bridge that made this alliance possible.
